Camps are tailored to meet individual athlete needs. You can learn everything from a basic t-set 360 to perfecting your doubles.

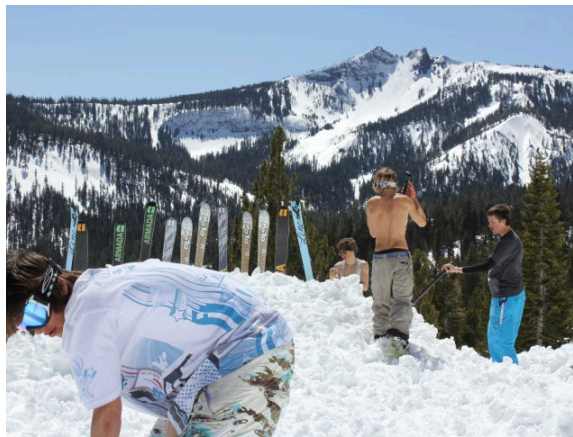
